MEMBER RECIPE:

Chipotle and Rosemary Roasted Nuts from Susie Borowicz

Ingredients:

3 cups whole roasted unsalted cashews (14 oz) 2 cups whole walnut halves (7 oz) 2 cups whole pecan halves (7 oz) 1/2 cup whole almonds (3 oz) 1/3 cup pure maple syrup 1/4 cup light brown sugar

3 Tbsp freshly squeezed orange juice2 tsp ground chipotle powder4 Tbsp minced fresh rosemary leaves, driedKosher saltVegetable oil

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Brush a sheet pan generously with vegetable oil. Combine all nuts, 2 Tbsp of vegetable oil, the maple syrup, brown sugar, orange juice & chipotle powder on the sheet pan. Toss to coat the nuts evenly. Add 2 Tbsp of rosemary and 2 tsp of salt and toss again.

Spread the nuts on two bakery sheets (you can use aluminum foil for ease of clean-up). Bake pans separately. Roast for 25 minutes (watch CLOSELY last 5 minutes!!), stirring twice with a large metal spatula, until the nuts are glazed and golden brown. Remove from oven and sprinkle with more salt (to taste) and remaining 2 Tbsp of rosemary.

Toss well and set aside at room temperature, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking as they cool. Taste for seasoning. Serve warm or cool completely and store in airtight containers at room temperature.
